GUIDELINES

MANDATORY AND ELECTIVE COURSES:

- The curriculum is made up of mandatory courses, elective courses and vocational visit sessions at the SWISS BIOHEALTH EDUCATION CENTER.
- The 5 mandatory courses and 8 vocational visits must be booked individually.
- Full credit is given for previously completed courses and vocational visits at SWISS BIOHEALTH EDUCATION

SUBMISSION OF CASE DOCUMENTATION (100 CERAMIC IMPLANTS):

- At least 100 completed and documented ceramic implants must be submitted.
- The case documentation must be created as a photo book (at least DIN A4 format): X-ray / panoramic (OPG) and photos preoperative, postoperative and final prosthetics.
- 100% of the submitted cases must feature prosthetic restoration.
- Minimum requirement: The implanted quadrant must be free of amalgam, metals and root-treated teeth.
- Submission deadline for the photobook: 4 weeks before the exam date.
- Admission to the examination takes place after reviewing the photo book and approval by the examination board.

WRITTEN TEST:

- The written test has a total duration of 90 minutes.
- The written examination is considered passed if at least 80% of the questions have been answered correctly.
- All questions will be discussed in detail during the courses at the SWISS BIOHEALTH EDUCATION CENTER.
- All answers for the curriculum can be found in the current documentation of the Swiss Dental Solutions and the SWISS BIOHEALTH CONCEPT®.

YOU HAVE THE POSSIBILITY TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL POINTS THROUGH THE FOLLOWING TASK:

- Additional points can be achieved by preparing a scientific article on a certain topic. This must be at least 5 and up to a maximum of 10 A4 pages in size, submitted in PDF format, and must contain at least 10 literature references from PubMed.de.
If you are interested in this option, please get in touch in good time so that we can provide you with examples of appropriate topics (example: vitamin K2 and blood thinners).
Submission deadline for the photobook: 4 weeks before the exam date.

ORAL EXAMINATION

- Questions on the submitted case documentation.
- Questions regarding the questions from the written test that were either not answered, incorrectly answered or not answered in full.
